<u>CANCELLATION POLICY</u> – Notification of cancellation must be made in writing to the Potato Conference at least fourteen (14) business days prior to the Trade Show opening. When notification is received, 75 percent of the fee will be refunded. No refunds will be made after the fourteen-day deadline.

<u>Name Badges</u> – Badges for those staffing the booth or those attending the Conference can be purchased online at <u>www.potatoconference.com</u> for \$10.00 pre-show or \$20.00 during the show. All Exhibitors and Attendees **MUST** have their own badge and be wearing it at **ALL** times.

No name badges will be pre-printed. All badges will be printed on-site at Registration or in the Show Office in the Three Rivers Convention Center. No one will be allowed to enter the Trade Show without their badges, so if you have booth staff that will be working later in the week, they can print their badges at the time of their arrival at Registration.






